1. Worth of article
2. Material and trimmings, appropriateness, quality
3. Workmanship- method of construction, choice and execution of stitches

Dressmaking- Simple house dresses, shirtwaist, shirt, simple school dress for girl to be judged on:

1. Material- its appropriateness, quality, color and design
2. Design- Simplicity of line, harmony of color appropriateness
3. Workmanship- method of construction, choice and execution of stitches

Embroidery and Crocheting- simple design and edges for trimming to be judge on:

1. Worth of article
2. Material- appropriateness and suitability for use which it was made.
3. Design- simplicity and appropriateness
4. Workmanship

Knitting- to be judged on:

1. Worth of article
2. Workmanship- execution of stitches, perfection
